1.0 Introduction

The Suwannee-Satilla Regional Water Planning Council (the Suwannee-Satilla Council) was established in February 2009 as part of the Georgia State-Wide Water Planning Process. The Suwannee-Satilla Council recognized the importance of providing opportunities for diverse input throughout the regional planning process. This Technical Memorandum outlines the approach that the Suwannee-Satilla Council followed to accomplish outreach during the water planning process.

During the first several months of water planning, the Suwannee-Satilla Council established stakeholder contact lists and developed a Public Involvement Plan. The Suwannee-Satilla Council formally adopted a Public Involvement Plan in November 2009 (Attachment A to this Technical Memorandum). The Public Involvement Plan was used to guide public involvement activities and to seek valuable input from key stakeholders, members of the local government, water providers, and the general public.

Council meetings were the primary mechanism for engaging the general public and other key stakeholders in the planning process. The Suwannee-Satilla Council executed 10 council meetings between May 2009 and February 2010. At each meeting, the council provided the opportunity for local government officials and the public to comment. In addition to council meetings, the Suwannee-Satilla Council utilized the Georgia State Water Plan website www.suwanneesatilla.org as the principal means to share Council materials and information.

2.0 Public Outreach Process

The sections below further describe the public outreach process that was utilized by the Suwannee-Satilla Council.

2.1 Suwannee-Satilla Council Meeting Announcements

The purpose of public outreach was to establish an open, informed and inclusive planning process. To help accomplish this goal, all Suwannee-Satilla Council meetings were conducted as open meetings. Once meeting dates, times, and locations were finalized, public notices were prepared in the format provided by the Georgia Environmental Protection Division. Prepared public notices were posted on the Georgia State Water Plan website homepage and the Suwannee-Satilla portion of the website. Public notices of the meetings were also circulated in advance of the meetings via e-mail distribution. During the planning process four separate e-mail lists were developed and maintained for this purpose and are listed below:

- Local Government Advisory Body list;
- Local Government Advisory Body Designate list;
- Interested Parties list; and
- Legal Organs list.

These e-mail lists are included in Attachment B to this Technical Memorandum. All four e-mail distribution lists were continuously updated as updates were received from the Georgia Environmental Protection Division or when requests were obtained from interested stakeholders. In addition to circulating the public notices to the various e-mail distribution lists described above, the meeting notices were also posted at the meeting location to inform the general public of the meeting.

2.1.1 Local Government Advisory Body List

The Georgia Comprehensive State-wide Water Management Plan (State-wide Water Plan), (January, 2008), established the state-wide regional water planning process. Section 14 (3) f.iii of the State-wide Water Plan included provisions for an advisory body of local elected officials, comprised of one representative from each county and city in the water planning regions. In conformance with this provision, a Local Government Advisory Body list was developed for the Suwannee-Satilla Council which consisted of the Chair of the County Commission for the counties in the region, and the mayors of each of the cities and towns in the region.

2.1.2 Local Government Advisory Body Designate List

As the water planning process got underway, it was recognized that local government officials may not be able to attend all council meetings. To facilitate communication with local governments, Georgia Environmental Protection Division coordinated with the Association County Commissioners of Georgia (ACCG) and the Georgia Municipal Association (GMA) to identify designees for the Local Government Advisory Body contacts as an additional means to obtain input to the regional planning process. Contact information for the officials on the Local Government Designate list was collected by ACCG and GMA at the beginning of the planning process and was provided to the Suwannee-Satilla Council by the Georgia Environmental Protection Division.

2.1.3 Interested Parties List

The Interested Parties list included City Clerks, Managers, and Administrators within the planning regions, as well as any member of the general public who expressed interest in the planning process and requested to be added to the list.

2.1.4 Legal Organs List

A list of Legal Organs, media communication outlets in the region that publish official public notices, were identified by the Suwannee-Satilla Council. Meeting notices were sent to the legal organs in the form of press releases prior to the meetings. Paid legal notices were not purchased but, legal organs were afforded the opportunity to publish the press releases.

2.2 Meeting Agenda, Pre-meeting and Meeting Materials

Meeting agenda and pre-meeting materials were posted on the Georgia State Water Plan homepage and the Suwannee-Satilla Council portion of the state water plan

website after they had been circulated to the Council Members. The Council Members and the entities listed above were also directed to the website where the meeting agenda, pre-meeting material, time, location, and directions to the meeting facility were posted. Meeting summaries were compiled after the completion of meetings and sent for approval from the Suwannee-Satilla Council Chair, Vice-Chair and the Georgia Environmental Protection Division. After the initial approval and distribution to the Council Members, the meeting summary, presentations, and handouts were posted to the Georgia State Water Plan and Suwannee-Satilla portion of the website. The meeting summaries were formally approved by the Council at the subsequent council meeting.

2.3 Local Government and Public Comment Opportunities

Local government officials were allocated a designated time to provide comments to the council at each council meeting. All public attendees at each council meeting were also provided a timeslot to provide comments to the Council. Comments were documented and incorporated into the meeting summary. The council meetings witnessed representation from local government officials, regional commissions, local industries, businesses and a variety of other stakeholders. Input obtained from these entities along the planning process has been used to enhance the planning process.

During the council meetings, attendance lists were recorded for the Suwannee-Satilla Council members and other entities that attended the meetings. These lists are included in Attachment C to this Technical Memorandum.

2.4 Additional Local Government and Stakeholder Input

The implementation of the regional plans is a crucial factor to be considered in the planning process and the importance of the local government input has been recognized and obtained throughout the planning process. Targeted outreach was carried out during the forecasting process and input from local government officials was obtained. Public notice periods were also provided after the completion of the population forecasts, economic/employment forecasts and the resource assessments. Public comments received were compiled and relevant information was incorporated with Council approval. Some of the specific outreach efforts of the Suwannee-Satilla Council are listed below:

- Outreach to Local Utilities – Nine municipal water providers were contacted during the forecast outreach process to refine county water use rates.
- Outreach to Local Industries – Several large local industries were contacted to accurately represent water and wastewater in forecast.
- The South Georgia Regional Commission was contacted during the process of gathering information regarding water quality and management practices.

- Outreach was conducted with the Georgia Soil and Water Conservation Commission at their annual irrigation meetings and a status update on the planning process was provided.
- The council also had presentations in Council Meetings by the entities listed below:
 - The South Georgia Regional Commission on the total maximum daily load development process and delisting of reaches within the region.
 - The Georgia Forestry Commission regarding forestry Best Management Practices.
 - The Wildlife Resource Division on developing a deeper understanding of water resource dependent ecosystems in the region.
 - The Suwannee River Water Management District on water supply planning in the district.

Further stakeholder input was obtained during the process of refining management practices and during discussions regarding the implementation of management practices. Each county, city, town in the planning region was listed along with the population and the major public supplier as identified in the USGS 2009 report “Water Use in Georgia by County for 2005”. The list was compared to the Council contact lists to identify any major omissions. Major/larger entities were selected for targeted outreach. Stakeholders were also identified for locations with known water quality problems and locations with existing surface water gaps. The Planning Contractor also compiled the list of public stakeholders that attended the Council meetings to identify and target stakeholders for additional outreach. Several council members conducted outreach to various stakeholders. Comments provided by the stakeholders were documented and incorporated for Council consideration.

2.5 Coordination with Other Regional Water Planning Councils

The Suwannee-Satilla Council also identified members to attend joint council meetings to plan and coordinate shared water resource needs with adjacent councils. A series of joint regional planning council meetings were held in January, 2010 to discuss the preliminary resource assessment results. A second joint meeting was held in October, 2010 to discuss shared issues and solutions, proposed management practices and to integrate planning efforts across boundaries. Joint meetings were attended by the Suwannee-Satilla Council members and provided the Suwannee-Satilla Council opportunities to learn about other council issues, share concerns and assess their progress in the planning process. In addition, coordination with shared resource planning contractors was conducted on numerous occasions to identify and incorporate water quantity and quality needs that affect resources that are shared between regions.

Attachment A - Adopted Public Involvement Plan

Suwannee-Satilla Regional Water Planning Council Public Involvement Plan

This document summarizes the Public Involvement Plan which will guide public involvement activities of the Suwannee-Satilla Regional Water Planning Council (Council). This Plan establishes the public involvement activities that will be undertaken by the Council.

The Chair of the Council will use discretion in permitting additional public comment or adjusting to adapt to specific meeting timelines and constraints, so long as the intent and expectations described below are followed.

During the regional planning process the Council, with assistance from their regional planning contractors, will implement this Public Involvement Plan to provide opportunities for meaningful input from key stakeholders, the members of local government advisory body, and the general public.

Guiding principles

The Suwannee-Satilla regional water planning council recognizes the benefit and importance of providing opportunities for diverse input throughout the regional water planning process. The principles of the public input process are:

- Stakeholders and regional water planning council members will treat each other with respect and dignity;
- All participants will have an open mind and participate openly and honestly;
- The regional water planning process will continue with concurrent public comment throughout;
- EPD will provide public notice and take public comment on draft regional water plans after they are submitted;
- Stakeholder comments will be pertinent to the topic of the meeting at which they are expressed; and
- Input from the public, key stakeholders, and the members of the Local Government Advisory Body will be actively sought, directed to the Chairman, considered, and incorporated in regional water planning council work products.

Key stakeholders

The key stakeholders for the Suwannee-Satilla water planning region are identified below. All members of the public will have opportunities for input, even if not specifically identified in this section.

Public Involvement Plan

- Local Government officials – includes one representative from each city and county within the water planning region.
- Neighboring regional water planning councils – water planning councils that share borders and/or water resources.
- Regional Commissions – agencies supporting local and regional comprehensive planning.
- Agriculture – includes water permit holders for agricultural applications and all other agricultural interests.
- Businesses – includes local businesses (this audience may be sub-divided into more specific categories).
- Industries – includes industrial water permit holders, industrial discharge permit holders, and municipally-supplied industrial facilities.
- Forestry – includes owners of managed forest lands and the forest products industry, including water-use holders and discharge permit holders.
- Institutions/educational/schools – includes public and private schools as well as institutions.
- Tourism – includes public and private organizations related to local travel and tourism.
- Recreation – includes citizens and industry related to recreational water uses and recreational water-use industries.
- Environment – includes citizens, agencies, and groups focused on environmental restoration and protection.
- Public – any citizen interested in the regional water planning process.

Procedural criteria

Time will be provided at every regional water planning council meeting for input from stakeholders and the public. The procedural criteria are intended to ensure the public respects the regional water planning council's schedule constraints and the regional water planning council respects the public's opportunity to present relevant and different opinions. To facilitate a fair and efficient process, the Suwannee-Satilla water planning council has adopted the following procedures for public comment.

- All full regional water planning council meetings will be open meetings.
- Stakeholders will be provided an opportunity to provide comments pertinent to the topic of the meeting in which they are expressed.

- Time will be provided at the beginning and end of all Suwannee-Satilla regional water planning council meetings for comments.
- Provisions for written comments will be made at all regional water planning council meetings.

The Chair of the regional water planning councils will use discretion to manage public comment under different circumstances in ways that enable the council to progress with its work and respect those who want to comment.

Meeting announcements

All regional water planning council meetings will be open meetings, including at least a 72-hour notice of any meetings. The following provisions will be made for all planning council meetings to inform the public of upcoming meetings.

- Posted on the Suwannee-Satilla regional water planning council website with a meeting agenda or summary of topics to be covered, meeting time, and meeting address.
- Posted at the meeting location with a meeting agenda or summary of topics to be covered, meeting time, and meeting address.
- Meeting summaries will be posted on the Suwannee-Satilla regional water planning council website and distributed to the following SE Georgia media-contact list:

Stakeholder and public comment opportunities

Specific opportunities during the regional water planning process for stakeholder and public input include but are not limited to the following:

- Meetings of the Suwannee-Satilla regional water planning council.
- Suwannee-Satilla regional water planning council website (documents will be posted periodically with timeframes for comment and mechanisms for comment clearly stated).
- Letters may be mailed to EPD with a copy to Rick Brown and Cliff Lewis.
- Emails to the regional water planning council Chairman and/or EPD.
- EPD public notice period for the resource assessments.
- EPD public notice period on the draft regional water plans.

Local government officials

Much of the implementation of the regional water plans is the responsibility of local governments; therefore input will be sought from the local government officials on the following specific topics.

- Regional population, economic and employment forecasts
- Fiscal implications of water management practices
- Draft regional water plan

The regional water planning council and local government officials should identify proper communication pathways. The following actions are intended to coordinate activities of the local government officials with the regional water planning councils.

- Local government officials are encouraged to attend the meetings and will be provided an opportunity at the beginning and end of the regional water planning council meetings to comment on the regional water planning process and items on the meeting agenda
- Local government officials may provide written comments to the regional water planning council, as needed.

Other regional water planning councils

In order to plan and coordinate the use and protection of shared water resources, the regional water planning council will coordinate with adjacent and hydrologically-connected councils throughout the regional water planning process. EPD will convene some meetings to discuss shared water resources, such as on the current resource assessments. The regional water planning councils will use the following communication pathways to coordinate with adjacent regional water planning councils.

- Members of the regional water planning council will attend shared resource meetings and other joint meetings
- At the discretion of the Chair, an opportunity may be provided at regional water planning council meetings for announcements or progress reports from adjacent regional water planning councils

The Chair of the regional water planning councils may use their discretion to provide additional coordination with adjacent regional water planning councils, as deemed appropriate.

Review and consideration of public input

The objective of this process is to gather relevant and diverse input to improve the quality of the recommended regional water plans. Once public comments are received from the public and key stakeholders the regional water planning council with the
